1/22 Water Heater goes out - no hot water in the house Replacement: \$875

1/15 Transmission in our only car goes out - grounded, dependent on family for basic trips to the store. Rebuild: \$110

Sept: Hurricane IKE ramed through Marshall / East Texas causing \$6000 damages to our property in Marshall, TX

Property tax on Marshall's property: \$3500

Property tax on the parsonage in Garland: \$4000

Thus, as we are facing these mountains, **we are praying many of you will rush to our side.**

We cannot continue to provide our 32 websites, 7 blogs and 2 weekly webcasts to the nearly 3 million visiting, learning about life saving help during their crisis moments without your help.
